Dear Judge Oetken:

Pursuant to ECF No. 63, the Parties submit the following joint status update.

The Parties report that they are engaged in settlement conversations and agree that a temporary adjournment of the Court's deadline for summary judgment briefing would allow the Parties adequate time to determine whether early resolution of the case is possible.

The Parties propose the summary judgment deadline be extended from December 8, 2023 to January 31, 2024, and that the Parties submit another joint status update on or before January 5, 2024, in which we will either ask Your Honor to revisit the January 31 deadline or to set a briefing schedule given the Court's rules on seriatim filings.

It is Defendants' position that referral to a Magistrate Judge or to the Court's mediation program would not necessarily aid in settlement discussions due to the particular posture of this case; however, Defendants remain open to the possibility depending on how the Parties' conversations progress. Plaintiffs are open to mediation if it would be beneficial. Accordingly, the Parties propose that they continue to hold settlement conversations privately, but that they will inform the Court immediately should such a referral appear beneficial.
